The Health Careers Opportunity Program (HCOP) is a comprehensive program designed to help and prepare students today, to be health professionals for tomorrow. West Virginia University will conduct a six-week summer residential program for students interested in medicine, dentistry, and pharmacy or for students interested in allied health. The Preliminary Education (PE) program is designed to aid incoming college freshman students to prepare academically and personally for the rigors of a health profession education. High School students that will be seniors as of Fall 2009 and have an interest in Dental Hygiene only, can also apply. The primary goal of this project is to provide students with the knowledge, skills, support, and abilities to enter and graduate from post-secondary schools offering careers in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, medical technology and dental hygiene. **Only 30 students will be selected!** **Students enrolled will receive a stipend to cover all expected costs of participating in this summer enrichment program; such as housing, supplies and food.**
